Certified programs will be hosted and promoted by CTGBC under its newly acquired GBCI Education Provider designation. Attendees will receive continuing education (CE) credits supporting their LEED professional credential maintenance.

The CTGBC has within its membership and friends a number of talented professionals who can contribute to the continuing growth and development of Connecticut's LEED professionals. - Minimum 50 minutes of instruction time
- Content geared to increase the competency of LEED professionals, and support valid green building practices in a vendor-neutral manner
- Developed and presented by instructor qualified in the subject matter

- Abstract or outline describing course content
- Learning Objectives (What will participants gain from attending this event?)
- Primary audience (Building owners? Residential contractors? Architects? Engineers?)
- Instructional time
- Brief bio describing Instructor's qualification to present this content
